- 1 (b) "Solar panel or solar collector" means a device used to
- 2 collect and convert solar energy into electricity or thermal
- 3 energy. Solar panel or solar collector includes, but is not limited
- 4 to, photovoltaic cells, photovoltaic panels, or solar thermal
- 5 systems.
- 6 Sec. 3. A homeowners association shall not prohibit the
- 7 installation of solar panels or solar collectors on the property of
- 8 its members.
