

SENATE BILL NO. 1053

May 19, 2022, Introduced by Senator BARRETT and referred to the Committee on Education and Career Readiness.

A bill to amend 2018 PA 548, entitled
"Comprehensive school safety plan act,"
(MCL 28.801 to 28.809) by adding section 11.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Sec. 11. (1) By not later than 180 days after the effective
2 date of the amendatory act that added this section, the commission
3 shall issue a report to the committees of the house of
4 representatives and the senate with jurisdiction over
5 appropriations and matters pertaining to school safety that
6 includes, but is not limited to, all of the following:

1 (a) An evaluation and itemization of all factors that may be
2 utilized to mitigate acts of school violence.

3 (b) The identification of the methods of communication,
4 collaboration, and use of technology that are critical to
5 identifying, analyzing, and investigating pre-incident indicators
6 of possible future incidents of school violence. As used in this
7 subdivision, "pre-incident indicators" includes, but is not limited
8 to, statements made, social media posts, artwork or drawings, and
9 other behavioral indicators or self-expressions that may be a
10 warning sign of a future incidence of school violence.

11 (c) A list of action items it believes the department, with
12 the cooperation of the department of health and human services and
13 the department of education, should take to mitigate acts of school
14 violence before they occur.

15 (d) A recognition of the ways both human and technological
16 capabilities can be leveraged to establish a system of
17 communication, investigation, reporting, and data analysis to
18 mitigate acts of school violence at schools in this state.

19 (2) If the legislature appropriates funding to the department
20 to mitigate, in consultation with the department of health and
21 human services and the department of education, acts of school
22 violence before they occur, the department shall comply with the
23 section of law that appropriates the funding, and, as prescribed in
24 that section of law, shall mitigate acts of school violence before
25 they occur for the receipt of that funding.
