

SENATE BILL NO. 1109

June 30, 2022, Introduced by Senators IRWIN, BAYER, GEISS and CHANG and referred to the Committee on Regulatory Reform.

A bill to prohibit the sale of certain vapor products; and to prescribe penalties.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Sec. 1. As used in this act:

2 (a) "Person" means an individual or a partnership,
3 corporation, limited liability company, association, governmental
4 entity, or other legal entity.

5 (b) "Vapor product" means that term as defined in section 4 of
6 the youth tobacco act, 1915 PA 31, MCL 722.644.

1 Sec. 3. (1) A person shall not sell a vapor product that has a
2 heating element unless the heating element is made of or encased in
3 1 or both of the following:

4 (a) Glass.

5 (b) Ceramic.

6 (2) A person that violates this section is guilty of a
7 misdemeanor punishable as follows:

8 (a) For a first violation, imprisonment for not more than 93
9 days or a fine of not more than \$200.00, or both.

10 (b) For a second or subsequent violation, imprisonment for not
11 more than 180 days or a fine of \$1,000.00, or both.
