## ENROLLED HOUSE BILL No. 4705

AN ACT to amend 1976 PA 267, entitled "An act to require certain meetings of certain public bodies to be open to the public; to require notice and the keeping of minutes of meetings; to provide for enforcement; to provide for invalidation of governmental decisions under certain circumstances; to provide penalties; and to repeal certain acts and parts of acts," (MCL 15.261 to 15.275) by adding section 9a.

The People of the State of Michigan enact:

Sec. 9a. (1) Every meeting of a public body that is a state licensing board, state commission panel, or state rule-making board, except a meeting or part of a meeting held in closed session, must be recorded in a manner that allows for the capture of sound, including, without limitation, in any of the following formats:

- (a) A sound-only recording.
- (b) A video recording with sound and picture.
- (c) A digital or analog broadcast capable of being recorded.
