2	deployed in our Nation's Capital since mid-January to assist with
3	security for the Inauguration and in the days following; and
4	Whereas, They have proudly answered the call, served our
5	country, and continue to make our state proud; and
6	Whereas, In recent weeks there have been reports of soldiers
7	being served undercooked and contaminated food; and
8	Whereas, This is unacceptable and an embarrassment to the D.C.
9	leadership accountable for this mission; now, therefore, be it
10	Resolved by the House of Representatives, That we call on the
11	National Guard Bureau to end the food contract for the 1,000
12	Michigan National Guard currently deployed to Washington, D.C., and
13	provide a per diem food allowance backdated to the start of the
14	mobilization; and be it further
15	Resolved, That copies of this resolution be transmitted to the
16	Chief of the National Guard Bureau and the Adjutant General and
17	Director of the Michigan Department of Military and Veterans
18	Affairs.
