- Whereas, Grassroots movements are often organized by everyday 1 2 people rather than elected leaders; and Whereas, Precinct delegates represent the smallest level of 3 organization in our districting system; and 4 5 Whereas, Precinct delegates must be residents of their 6 precinct and act as the link between their community and their 7 elected party; and 8 Whereas, Precinct delegates are often the principal organizers 9 of grassroots work in their neighborhoods, calling upon their 10 network of connections to move forward a worthy cause; and 11 Whereas, Precinct delegates commit themselves to many important duties, including registering their neighbors to vote and 12 13 electing candidates in party conventions based on the preferences 14 of their precinct; and 15 Whereas, Precinct delegates and grassroots organizers are deserving of recognition for their sacrifice of time, energy, and 16 passion that is essential for building participation in our 17 democracy; now, therefore, be it 18 19 Resolved by the House of Representatives, That the members of 20 this legislative body declare June 23-29, 2022, as Grassroots Week in the state of Michigan.
