HOUSE RESOLUTION NO.10

Rep. Camilleri offered the following resolution: 1 A resolution to censure Representative Matt Maddock of the 2 Forty-Fourth House District, State of Michigan. 3 Whereas, Article IV, Section 16 of the Constitution of the 4 State of Michigan of 1963 provides, in relevant part: Each house, except as otherwise provided constitution, shall choose its own officers and determine 6 7 the rules of its proceedings ... Each house shall be the 8 sole judge of the qualifications, elections and returns of 9 its members... ; and 10 Whereas, Article XI, Section 1 of the Constitution of the 11 12 State of Michigan of 1963 provides, in relevant part:

All officers, legislative, executive and judicial, before

- entering upon the duties of their respective offices, shall 1 take and subscribe the following oath or affirmation: I do 2 solemnly swear (or affirm) that I will support the 3 Constitution of the United States and the constitution of 4 5 this state, and that I will faithfully discharge the duties 6 of the office of according to the best of my 7 ability. No other oath, affirmation, or any religious test 8 shall be required as a qualification for any office or 9 public trust.

- 11 Whereas, House Rule 74(6) states:
- 12 A Member shall conduct himself or herself to justify the
- confidence placed in him or her by the people and shall,
- 14 by personal example and admonition to colleagues, maintain
- the integrity and responsibility of his or her office

- Whereas, House Rule 74(7) states:
- 18 A Member shall not engage in any conduct that materially
- impairs the ability of the Member to perform the duties of
- his or her office or substantially impair the public
- 21 confidence in the House.

- 23 Whereas, Representative Matt Maddock has engaged in a pattern
- 24 of misconduct that has undermined the public's confidence in him,
- 25 in the House, and in Michigan's electoral process and democratic
- 26 institutions in violation of his Oath of Office and the Standing
- 27 Rules of the House of Representatives; and
- 28 Whereas, Representative Matt Maddock has participated in
- 29 frivolous legal proceedings seeking to undermine Michigan's

- 1 election laws, duly enacted by the Michigan Legislature, and to
- 2 subvert the manifest will of the citizens of Michigan as expressed
- 3 in the 2020 general election; and
- 4 Whereas, Representative Matt Maddock repeatedly fomented armed
- 5 intimidation and threats of political violence against legislators,
- 6 legislative staff, other elected officials, and the citizens of the
- 7 state of Michigan in violation of his Oath of Office and the
- 8 Standing Rules of the House of Representatives; and
- 9 Whereas, Representative Matt Maddock was present for, and
- 10 assisted in organizing Michiganders to participate in, the
- 11 seditious insurrection that took place in Washington, D.C., on
- 12 January 6, 2021, during the counting of electoral votes; and
- 13 Whereas, Representative Matt Maddock's actions have drawn
- 14 national attention and disrepute to the state of Michigan, the
- 15 Michigan Legislature, and the Michigan House of Representatives,
- 16 shaking the public trust and confidence in this legislative body,
- 17 in Michigan's electoral process, and in our democratic
- 18 institutions; and striking the honor, dignity, and integrity of
- 19 this body; and

- 20 Whereas, Public trust and confidence in the legislature, the
- 21 electoral process, and democratic institutions are prerequisites to
- 22 the functioning of a democratic society; now, therefore, be it
- 23 Resolved by the House of Representatives, That Representative
- 24 Matt Maddock of the Forty-Fourth House District, State of Michigan,
- 25 has conducted acts inconsistent with the trust and duties of a
- 26 state representative. He has endangered his colleagues in the
- 27 Michigan Legislature, endeavored to delegitimize Michigan's
- 28 electoral process, and done considerable harm to public confidence
- 29 in state government. He has failed to maintain the integrity and

- 1 responsibility of his office and to meet his solemn obligations to
- 2 the people of the state of Michigan; and be it further
- 3 Resolved, That in accordance with the above-cited provisions
- 4 of the Constitution of the State of Michigan of 1963 and the
- 5 Standing Rules of the House of Representatives, Representative Matt
- 6 Maddock is hereby censured by the Michigan House of
- 7 Representatives; and be it further
- 8 Resolved, That a copy of this resolution be delivered to
- 9 Representative Matt Maddock.
