HOUSE RESOLUTION NO.266

Rep. Calley offered the following resolution:

- 1 A resolution to declare April 2022 as Autism Awareness Month
- 2 in the state of Michigan.
- 3 Whereas, Autism refers to a range of conditions characterized
- 4 by challenges with social skills, repetitive behaviors, speech, and
- 5 nonverbal communication, as well as by unique strengths and
- 6 differences. In 2013, the American Psychiatric Association merged
- 7 four previously distinct diagnoses into one umbrella diagnosis of
- 8 autism spectrum disorder (ASD). These included autistic disorder,
- 9 childhood disintegrative disorder, pervasive developmental
- 10 disorder-not otherwise specified (PDD-NOS), and Asperger syndrome.
- 11 It is the result of a neurological disorder that affects the normal
- 12 functioning of the brain that is believed to be caused by genetic
- 13 and environmental factors; and

Whereas, Families living with autism face unique challenges 1 2 and frequently experience significant financial costs for specialized education and support services. The uniqueness of each 3 individual with autism makes the experience of living with autism 4 5 different for each family; and 6 Whereas, Autism is a lifelong condition and the necessary 7 support and treatment changes as people on the spectrum move 8 through major life phases. Their quality of life depends not only 9 upon the foundation that is provided in childhood, but on ongoing 10 supports that are specific to the educational, medical, social, 11 recreational, family, and employment needs of the individual; and 12 Whereas, Autism knows no racial, ethnic, social boundaries, family income, lifestyle, or educational levels and can affect any 13 14 family and any child. Autism is the fastest-growing developmental 15 disability in the United States and it is estimated that it is 16 prevalent in 1 in every 59 children under the age of 8 and is four 17 times more likely to occur in boys than in girls; and 18 Whereas, April 2022 is National Autism Awareness Month; now, 19 therefore, be it 20 Resolved by the House of Representatives, That the members of 21 this legislative body declare April 2022 as Autism Awareness Month

in the state of Michigan.
