SENATE RESOLUTION NO.73

Senators Bullock, Chang, Polehanki, Wojno, McMorrow, McCann, Hollier, Brinks, Bayer, Irwin, Geiss, Ananich and Santana offered the following resolution:

- 1 A resolution to support the use of federal funding to provide
- 2 Hero pay to essential workers.
- 3 Whereas, Throughout the COVID-19 Pandemic, essential workers
- 4 have ensured that our society and economy were still able to
- 5 function. These dedicated Americans have provided incalculable
- 6 benefit to our state while disproportionately bearing the weight of
- 7 the crisis; and
- 8 Whereas, Essential workers have put themselves at increased
- 9 risk of exposure to the virus and of bringing the disease home to
- 10 their loved ones. This risk was often exacerbated by the lack of
- 11 proper personal protective equipment. Many have died after being

- 1 exposed to the virus at work; and
- 2 Whereas, It is necessary to ensure that essential workers are
- 3 compensated in a manner that reflects this sacrifice and their
- 4 importance to our society. In the United States, more than half of
- 5 all occupations with a median wage below \$15 per hour are essential
- 6 workers. While some companies have stepped in to provide Hero pay
- 7 to frontline employees, many have not; and
- 8 Whereas, The federal funding provided by the American Rescue
- 9 Plan Act has given our state the opportunity to fill the gap left
- 10 by private employers. Using federal aid to provide Hero pay to
- 11 essential employees will make certain that these heroes are
- 12 compensated; now, therefore, be it
- 13 Resolved by the Senate, That we support the use of federal
- 14 funding to provide Hero pay to essential workers; and be it further
- 15 Resolved, That copies of this resolution be transmitted to the
- 16 Governor.
