### **SUMMARY:**

Senate Bill 592 would amend the Opioid Liability Litigation Act<sup>1</sup> to prohibit a *political subdivision* of the state from commencing or maintaining an action (lawsuit) after January 1, 2022, that is related to the released claims in the following settlement agreements (which arise out of *In re Nat'l Prescription Opiate Litigation*<sup>2</sup>) against the released entities as defined in those agreements:<sup>3</sup>

- The master settlement agreement entered into by the state with Allergan Pharmaceuticals.
- The master settlement agreement entered into by the state with CVS Pharmacy.
- The master settlement agreement entered into by the state with Teva Pharmaceuticals.
- The master settlement agreement entered into by the state with Walgreens Pharmacy.
- The master settlement agreement entered into by the state with Walmart.

**Political subdivision** means a public body corporate in Michigan, an agency of a public body corporate in Michigan, a nonincorporated body in Michigan of whatever nature, or an agency of a nonincorporated body in Michigan. The term includes a county, city, village, township, school district, or special district or authority of the state, but does not include the state.
