## **SUMMARY:**

Senate Bill 702 would amend the Occupational Code to increase the number of hours of training required for an individual to be licensed as a cosmetology instructor, a manicurist, or an esthetician, for individuals that begin training on or after July 1, 2024, as follows:

Profession	Current Requirement	Proposed Requirement
Cosmetology instructor	500 hours	600 hours
Manicurist	400 hours	600 hours
Esthetician	400 hours	750 hours

MCL 339.1206 et al.
