SUMMARY:

House Bill 4288 would amend section 15 of 1947 PA 336 to remove references to a repealed section of the Revised School Code (section 1280c) ¹ that, among other things, affected how districts designated as low performing under certain state metrics engaged in collective bargaining and entered into collective bargaining agreements.

The bill is tie-barred to HB 4166, which means that it will not take effect unless HB 4166 is also enacted into law.

FISCAL IMPACT:

The bill would have no fiscal impact on the state or on school districts, intermediate school districts (ISDs), or public school academies (PSAs, or charter schools).
