SUMMARY:

House Bill 4647 would amend the Occupational Code to change the frequency at which the Department of Licensing and Regulatory Affairs is required to inspect barbershops and barber colleges.

Currently, the act requires barbershops to be inspected at least once a year and each barber college to be inspected twice a year after the initial inspection required to open the establishment.

The bill would require the department to conduct these inspections *regularly* following the initial inspection.
