## **SUMMARY:**

House Bill 5075 would amend the Michigan Penal Code to authorize a court to order a term of imprisonment imposed for any of the following offenses to be served consecutively to a term of imprisonment imposed for any other criminal offense arising from the same transaction:

- A violation of section 520c, criminal sexual conduct in the second degree.<sup>1</sup>
- A violation of section 520d, criminal sexual conduct in the third degree.<sup>2</sup>
- A violation of section 520e, criminal sexual conduct in the fourth degree.<sup>3</sup>
- A violation of section 520g, assault with intent to commit criminal sexual conduct involving sexual penetration or criminal sexual conduct in the second degree.<sup>4</sup>

Multiple sentences are served either concurrently (at the same time) or consecutively (one after another). Consecutive sentencing requires a statutory authorization (allowing it) or mandate (requiring it). The bill would provide authorization as related to the above offenses. Note that consecutive sentencing is already authorized for a violation of section 520b of the Michigan Penal Code (criminal sexual conduct in the first degree).

The bill would take effect 90 days after it is enacted.
