House Bill 5151 (as reported without amendment)

CONTENT

The bill would amend the Michigan Memorial Highway Act to designate the portion of Highway M-53 in Macomb County beginning at the intersection with 17 Mile Road and continuing north to the interchange with Hall Road as the "Officer Leroy Imus Memorial Highway".

BRIEF RATIONALE

Leroy Imus was born in Howell, Michigan in 1939. He served in the United States Navy until he was honorably discharged and then became a Sterling Heights Police Officer on September 12, 1966. On December 2, 1971, Officer Imus was killed returning to his patrol car during a traffic stop after 1:00 AM when a car swerved out of its travel lane and struck him and his patrol car. He was 32 years old. To honor his memory, it has been suggested that the State designate a highway in his name.
