SENATE SUBSTITUTE FOR HOUSE BILL NO. 4613

A bill to amend 1978 PA 368, entitled "Public health code,"

by amending section 20952 (MCL 333.20952), as amended by 2024 PA $_{48}$.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 20952. (1) The department may grant a nonrenewable
- 2 temporary license to an individual who has made proper application
- 3 with the required fee for licensure as a medical first responder,
- 4 emergency medical technician, emergency medical technician
- 5 specialist, or paramedic and who has successfully completed all of
- 6 the requirements for licensure except for the examinations
- 7 described in section 20950. A temporary license is valid for $\frac{120}{120}$
- 8 days 1 year from the date of an accepted application.

1	(2) An individual holding a temporary license as an emergency
2	medical technician under this section shall practice only under the
3	direct supervision of an emergency medical technician, emergency
4	medical technician specialist, or paramedic who holds a license
5	other than a temporary license.
6	(3) An individual holding a temporary license as an emergency
7	medical technician specialist shall practice only under the direct
8	supervision of an emergency medical technician specialist or
9	paramedic who holds a license other than a temporary license.
10	(4) An individual holding a temporary license as a paramedic
11	shall practice only under the direct supervision of a paramedic who
12	holds a license other than a temporary license.as provided under
13	section 20952a.
14	Enacting section 1. This amendatory act does not take effect
15	unless House Bill No. 4614 of the 102nd Legislature is enacted into
16	law.
