## SUBSTITUTE FOR HOUSE BILL NO. 5649

A bill to amend 1976 PA 451, entitled "The revised school code,"

(MCL 380.1 to 380.1852) by adding section 1166c.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Sec. 1166c. (1) Beginning with the 2027-2028 school year, each public high school shall offer at least 1 computer science course to pupils enrolled in the public high school, as determined by the district, intermediate school district, or public school academy.
- 5 (2) The computer science course described in subsection (1) 6 must meet the following criteria:
- 7 (a) It must meet or exceed standards established by the state 8 board of education.
- 9 (b) Except as otherwise provided in this subdivision, the

- 1 public high school must make a good-faith effort to offer the
- 2 course in an in-person setting. If an in-person setting is not
- 3 feasible for purposes of meeting the requirement under this
- 4 subdivision, the public high school may offer the course through a
- 5 virtual or distance-based option. The requirement to make a good-
- 6 faith effort to offer the course in an in-person setting does not
- 7 apply to a public high school that operates entirely virtually.
- 8 (c) It must be listed as an option on the school's catalog of
- 9 courses, as confirmed by the district, intermediate school
- 10 district, or public school academy.
- 11 (3) As used in this section:
- 12 (a) "Computer science" means the study of computers and
- 13 algorithmic processes, including, but not limited to, their
- 14 principles, hardware and software designs, implementation, and
- 15 impact on society, and is a study that focuses on teaching students
- 16 how to create new technologies and not solely the use of
- 17 technology.
- 18 (b) "Public high school" means a public school that offers at
- 19 least 1 of grades 9 to 12.
