THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 234d. (1) Except as provided in subsection (2), a person
- 2 shall not possess a firearm on the premises of any of the

- 4 (a) A depository financial institution or a subsidiary or
- 5 affiliate of a depository financial institution.

- (d) A person who possesses a firearm on the premises of an
 entity described in subsection (1) if that possession is with the
 permission of the owner or an agent of the owner of that entity.
 - (3) Except as provided in subsection (4), a person shall not, while absent voter ballots are being processed, possess a firearm in an absent voter counting place or a combined absent voter counting place or within 100 feet from any entrance to an absent voter counting place or a combined absent voter counting place.
- (4) Subsection (3) does not apply to a uniformed lawenforcement officer acting in the course of his or her duties.

- 1 misdemeanor punishable by imprisonment for not more than 90 days or
- 2 a fine of not more than \$100.00, or both.
