

HOUSE BILL NO. 4758

June 14, 2023, Introduced by Reps. Filler, Bezotte, Arbit, Steckloff, Breen, Shannon, McKinney, Edwards, Rheingans, Kuhn and Dievendorf and referred to the Committee on Regulatory Reform.

A bill to amend 1998 PA 58, entitled
"Michigan liquor control code of 1998,"
(MCL 436.1101 to 436.2303) by adding section 910.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Sec. 910. (1) With regard to issuing, denying, suspending, or
2 revoking a license under this act, the commission shall not
3 consider a qualified violation if at least 2 years have elapsed
4 since the act that resulted in the qualified violation.

5 (2) As used in this section:

6 (a) "Crime" means that term as defined in section 5 of the

1 Michigan penal code, 1931 PA 328, MCL 750.5.

2 (b) "Qualified violation" means a violation of this act other
3 than a crime or state civil infraction.

4 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act does not take effect
5 unless Senate Bill No. ____ or House Bill No. 4757 (request no.
6 02906'23) of the 102nd Legislature is enacted into law.
