## SENATE SUBSTITUTE FOR HOUSE BILL NO. 4698

A bill to amend 1954 PA 116, entitled "Michigan election law,"

by amending section 2 (MCL 168.2), as amended by 2024 PA 74.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 2. As used in this act:
- 2 (a) "Absent voter" is a voter who utilizes the process
- 3 described in section 759.
- 4 (b) "Absent voter ballot" means a ballot that is issued to a
- 5 voter through the absent voter process.
- 6 (c) "Ballot container" is defined in section 14a.
- 7 (d) "Ballot question committee" means that term as defined in
- 8 section 2 of the Michigan campaign finance act, 1976 PA 388, MCL
- 9 169.202.

- (e) "Business day" or "secular day" means a day that is not a
   Saturday, Sunday, or legal holiday.
- 3 (f) "Change the result of the election" means either of the 4 following:
- 5 (i) Elect a different candidate.
- 6 (ii) Result in the opposite outcome for a ballot question.
- 9 (h) "Common carrier" means a company that transports mail, on 10 reasonable request, on regular routes and at set rates.
- 11 (i) "Educational institution" means a public or private 12 institution, or a separate school or department of a public or 13 private institution, that is authorized by law or an accrediting body to grant or issue a diploma, degree, certificate, or license, 14 15 or to grant approval to practice a profession or engage in an 16 enterprise, and includes, but is not limited to, an academy, high 17 school, college, university, community college, junior college, secondary school, extension course, or a business, nursing, 18 professional, secretarial, technical, or vocational school. 19
- (j) "Election" means an election or primary election at which the electors of this state or of a subdivision of this state choose or nominate by ballot an individual for public office or decide a ballot question lawfully submitted to them.
- (k) "Election precinct" is defined in section 654.
- 25 (l) "Fall" state and county conventions and "spring" state and
  26 county conventions are assigned meanings in section 596.

- 1 (n) "Identification for election purposes" means, if issued to
- 2 the individual presenting the card or document and if presented for
- 3 voting purposes the name on the card or document sufficiently
- 4 matches the individual's name in the individual's voter
- 5 registration record so as to accurately identify the individual as
- 6 the registered elector, or if issued to the individual presenting
- 7 the card or document and if presented for voter registration
- 8 purposes, any of the following:
- 9 (i) An Except as otherwise provided in this subparagraph, an
- 10 operator's or chauffeur's license issued under the Michigan vehicle
- 11 code, 1949 PA 300, MCL 257.1 to 257.923, or an enhanced driver
- 12 license issued under the enhanced driver license and enhanced
- 13 official state personal identification card act, 2008 PA 23, MCL
- 14 28.301 to 28.308. This subparagraph does not include either of the
- 15 following:
- 16 (A) A mobile operator's or chauffeur's license issued under
- 17 section 310a of the motor vehicle code, 1949 PA 300, MCL 257.310a.
- 18 (B) A mobile enhanced driver license issued under section 4 of
- 19 the enhanced driver license and enhanced official state personal
- 20 identification card act, 2008 PA 23, MCL 28.304.
- 21 (ii) An-Except as otherwise provided in this subparagraph, an
- 22 official state personal identification card issued under 1972 PA
- 23 222, MCL 28.291 to 28.300, or an enhanced official state personal
- 24 identification card issued under the enhanced driver license and
- 25 enhanced official state personal identification card act, 2008 PA
- 26 23, MCL 28.301 to 28.308. This subparagraph does not include either
- 27 of the following:
- 28 (A) A mobile official state personal identification card
- 29 issued under section 2 of 1972 PA 222, MCL 28.292.

- 1 (B) A mobile enhanced official state personal identification
- 2 card issued under section 4 of the enhanced driver license and
- 3 enhanced official state personal identification card act, 2008 PA
- 4 23, MCL 28.304.
- 5 (iii) A current operator's or chauffeur's license issued by
- 6 another state.
- 7 (iv) A current state personal identification card issued by
- 8 another state.
- 9 (v) A current state government issued photo identification
- 10 card.
- 11 (vi) A current United States passport or federal government
- 12 issued photo identification card.
- 13 (vii) A current military photo identification card.
- 14 (viii) A current tribal photo identification card.
- (ix) A current photo identification card issued by a local
- 16 government.
- (x) A current student photo identification card issued by an
- 18 educational institution.
- 19 (o) "Immediate family" means an individual's father, mother,
- 20 son, daughter, brother, sister, and spouse and a relative of any
- 21 degree residing in the same household as that individual.
