

**SENATE SUBSTITUTE FOR
HOUSE BILL NO. 4718**

A bill to amend 1927 PA 175, entitled
"The code of criminal procedure,"
(MCL 760.1 to 777.69) by adding section 21d to chapter VIII.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

CHAPTER VIII

Sec. 21d. (1) Evidence of the discovery of, knowledge about,
or potential disclosure of an individual's actual or perceived sex,
gender identity, gender expression, or sexual orientation is not
admissible for any of the following purposes:

- (a) To demonstrate reasonable provocation.
- (b) To show that an act was committed in a heat of passion.
- (c) To support a defense of reduced mental capacity under
section 20a of this chapter.

1 (2) Notwithstanding the provisions of any other law of this
2 state, an individual is not justified in using force against
3 another individual based on the discovery of, knowledge about, or
4 potential disclosure of the victim's actual or perceived sex,
5 gender identity, gender expression, or sexual orientation.
