THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 1060. (1) When delivering a document described in this

- (2) The fees described in subsection (1) are in addition to
 any franchise fees prescribed in this act. The administrator shall
 not refund all or any part of a fee described in this section.
- 5 (3) Except as provided in subsection (9), the administrator
 6 shall deposit all fees received and collected under this section in
 7 the state treasury to the credit of the administrator, who may only
 8 use the money credited pursuant to in accordance with legislative
 9 appropriation and only in carrying out those duties of the
 10 department required by law.
 - (4) The fees described in this section apply to documents filed by a domestic or foreign regulated investment company as **that term is** defined in section 1064.
 - (5) If any money received by the administrator from fees paid under subsection (1)(u) is not appropriated to the department in that fiscal year, the money remaining from those fees shall revert reverts to the general fund of this state.
- (6) A minimum charge of \$1.00 for each certificate and 50 18 19 cents per folio shall must be paid to the administrator for 20 certifying a part of a file or record pertaining to a corporation 21 if a fee for that service is not described in subsection (1). The administrator may furnish copies of documents, reports, and papers 22 23 required or permitted by law to be filed with the administrator, 24 and shall charge for those copies the fee established in a schedule 25 of fees adopted by the administrator with the approval of the state 26 administrative board. The administrator shall retain the revenue 27 collected under this subsection, and the department shall use it to defray the costs for its copying and certifying services. 28
 - (7) If a domestic or foreign corporation pays fees or

- penalties by check and the check is dishonored, or by credit card
 and a chargeback is successful, the fee is unpaid and the
 administrator shall rescind the filing of all related documents.
 - (8) The administrator may accept a credit card in lieu of cash or check as payment of a fee under this act. The administrator shall determine which credit cards he or she shall accept the administrator accepts for payment.
 - (9) The administrator may charge a nonrefundable fee of up to not more than \$50.00 for any document submitted or certificate sent by facsimile or electronic transmission. The administrator shall retain the revenue collected under this subsection and the department shall use it to carry out its duties required by law.
 - (10) The administrator shall waive any fee otherwise required under this section if a majority of the shares of the domestic or foreign corporation responsible for paying the fee are, and the corporation provides proof satisfactory to the administrator that those shares are, held by 1 or more honorably discharged veterans of the Armed Forces of the United States.
