SENATE SUBSTITUTE FOR HOUSE BILL NO. 5143

A bill to amend 1976 PA 388, entitled "Michigan campaign finance act,"

by amending section 2 (MCL 169.202), as amended by 2001 PA 250.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 2. (1) "Artificial intelligence" means a machine-based
- 2 system that can, for a given set of human-defined objectives, make
- 3 predictions, recommendations, or decisions influencing real or
- 4 virtual environments, and that uses machine and human-based inputs
- 5 to do all of the following:
- 6 (a) Perceive real and virtual environments.
- 7 (b) Abstract such perceptions into models through analysis in
- 8 an automated manner.
- 9 (c) Use model inference to formulate options for information

1 or action.

- (2) (1) "Award" means a plaque, trophy, certificate, bust,
 ceremonial gavel, or memento.
- 4 (3) (2)—"Ballot question" means a question that is submitted
 5 or is intended to be submitted to a popular vote at an election
 6 whether or not it qualifies for the ballot.
- 7 (4) (3) "Ballot question committee" means a committee acting
 8 in support of, or in opposition to, the qualification, passage, or
 9 defeat of a ballot question but that does not receive contributions
 10 or make expenditures or contributions for the purpose of
 11 influencing or attempting to influence the action of the voters for
 12 or against the nomination or election of a candidate.
- 13 (5) (4)—"Bundle" means for a bundling committee to deliver 1
 14 or more contributions from individuals to the candidate committee
 15 of a candidate for statewide elective office, without the money
 16 becoming money of the bundling committee.
 - (6) (5)—"Bundling committee" means an independent committee or political committee that makes an expenditure to solicit or collect from individuals contributions that are to be part of a bundled contribution, which expenditure is required to be reported as an in-kind expenditure for a candidate for statewide elective office.
 - (7) (6)—"Business" means a corporation, limited liability company, partnership, sole proprietorship, firm, enterprise, franchise, association, organization, self-employed individual, holding company, joint stock company, receivership, trust, activity, or entity that is organized for profit or nonprofit purposes.
- Enacting section 1. This amendatory act does not take effect unless House Bill No. 5141 of the 102nd Legislature is enacted into
