SUBSTITUTE FOR HOUSE BILL NO. 5164

A bill to create the call center jobs retention act; to provide for the powers and duties of certain state governmental officers and entities; to impose certain duties on certain employers; and to prescribe civil sanctions.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Sec. 1. This act may be cited as the "call center jobs
 retention act".
- 3 Sec. 3. As used in this act:
- 4 (a) "Call center" means a centralized office used primarily
- 5 for receiving or transmitting customer requests or inquiries by
- 6 telephone.
- 7 (b) "Department" means the department of labor and economic
- 8 opportunity.

- (c) "Employer" means a person that employs, either full-time
 or part-time, 50 or more individuals at a call center.
- 3 (d) "Person" means an individual or a sole proprietorship,
- 4 partnership, association, corporation, or any other legal entity.
- 5 Sec. 5. (1) An employer shall notify the department at least
- 6 30 days before the employer does either of the following:
- 7 (a) Relocates either of the following from this state to a
- 8 foreign country:
- 9 (i) A call center.
- (ii) A facility or operating unit within a call center
- 11 comprising at least 30% of the call center's total call volume as
- 12 measured against the call center's average call volume during the
- 13 immediately preceding 12-month period.
- 14 (b) Closes or otherwise ceases the operations of a call center
- or of a facility or operating unit described in subdivision (a) (ii)
- 16 if the employer contracts with or intends to contract with a person
- 17 to provide the same services that the call center, facility, or
- 18 operating unit provided in a foreign country.
- 19 (2) An employer that violates subsection (1) is subject to a
- 20 civil fine of not more than \$10,000.00. The prosecutor of the
- 21 county in which the violation occurred or the attorney general may
- 22 bring an action to collect the fine. A fine collected must be
- 23 deposited in the general fund.
- Sec. 7. Beginning 6 months after the effective date of this
- 25 act, and every 6 months thereafter, the department shall compile a
- 26 registry of the employers required to provide notice under section
- 27 5(1) and publish the registry on its website. The registry must
- 28 include all of the following information:
- 29 (a) The name of the employer.

- 1 (b) The date of the relocation or closing, as applicable.
- 2 (c) The number of jobs to be relocated or eliminated, as
- 3 applicable.
- 4 (d) The location of the relocated or new call center,
- 5 facility, or operating unit, including the name of the city and the
- 6 country.
- 7 Enacting section 1. This act takes effect 90 days after the
- 8 date it is enacted into law.
