HOUSE SUBSTITUTE FOR SENATE BILL NO. 149

A bill to amend 1969 PA 224, entitled

"An act to license and regulate dealers in and research facilities using dogs and cats for research purposes; and to repeal certain acts and parts of acts,"

by amending the title and sections 1 and 7 (MCL 287.381 and 287.387) and by adding section 8a.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

TITLE

An act to license and regulate dealers in and that deliver,

transport, board, buy, or sell dogs or cats for laboratory research

purposes; to regulate research facilities using that use dogs and

or cats for laboratory research; purposes; to require research

facilities to offer laboratory animals no longer needed for

- 1 laboratory research to certain animal protection shelters for
- 2 adoption before euthanizing; to require research facilities to
- 3 submit annual reports; to provide immunity from civil liability
- 4 under certain conditions; to create certain funds; and to repeal
- 5 certain acts and parts of acts.
- 6 Sec. 1. When As used in this act:
- 7 (a) "Person" includes any individual, partnership, association
- 8 or corporation.
- 9 (b) "Director" means the director of the department of
- 10 agriculture.
- 11 (a) "Animal protection shelter" means a facility that is
- 12 registered under section 6 of 1969 PA 287, MCL 287.336, and is
- 13 operated by any of the following:
- 14 (i) A person.
- 15 (ii) A humane society.
- 16 (iii) A society for the prevention of cruelty to animals.
- 17 (iv) Any other nonprofit organization for the care of homeless 18 animals.

- 19 (b) (c) "Cat" means any live a domestic cat (felis catus) for
- 20 use or intended to be used for research, tests or experiments at
- 21 research facilities.of any age of the species Felis catus.
- 22 (c) "Dealer" means a person that for compensation or profit
- 23 delivers for transportation, transports, boards, buys, or sells
- 24 dogs or cats for research purposes. Dealer does not include a
- 25 person that breeds or raises dogs or cats for sale to a research
- 26 facility.
- (d) "Department" means the department of agriculture and rural
- 28 development.
- 29 (e) "Director" means the director of the department.

- 1 (f) (d) "Dog" means any live a domestic dog of any age of the
 2 species canis familiaris for use or intended to be used for
 3 research tests or experiments at research facilities.Canis lupus
 4 familiaris.
- 5 (g) "Laboratory animal" means a dog or cat that is used or 6 intended to be used for laboratory research at a research facility.
- 7 (h) "Laboratory research" means research, tests, or 8 experiments conducted for education, scientific, medical, or 9 experimental purposes.
 - (i) "Municipality" means a county, city, village, or township.
 - (j) "Person" means an individual, estate, business or nonprofit entity, public corporation, government or governmental subdivision, agency, or instrumentality, or other legal entity.
 - (k) (e)—"Research facility" means any a school, hospital, laboratory, institution, organization, or person that is licensed or otherwise registered with the United States Department of Agriculture, that uses or intends to use dogs or cats a laboratory animal in laboratory research, tests or experiments, and that (1) purchases does 1 or both of the following:
- 20 (i) Purchases or transports such animals, or (2) receives any21 laboratory animals.
- 22 (ii) Receives funds from the this state, or a local government,
 23 or any an agency or instrumentality thereof of this state or a
 24 local government to finance its operations by means of through
 25 grants, loans, or otherwise.other funds.
- (f) "Dealer" means any person who for compensation or profit
 delivers for transportation, transports, boards, buys or sells dogs
 or cats for research purposes and does not mean a person who breeds
 or raises dogs or cats for sale to a research facility.

- 1 Sec. 7. (1) Research facilities and dealers shall make and
- 2 keep such maintain any records with respect to their regarding the
- 3 purchase, sale, transportation, and handling of dogs and cats , as
- 4 the director may prescribe. for laboratory research, and research
- 5 facilities shall maintain any report submitted under section 11a. A
- 6 research facility shall maintain a report submitted under section
- 7 11a for 5 years.
- 8 (2) The department shall maintain and make available on its
- 9 website a list of all research facilities operating in this state.
- 10 Sec. 8a. (1) Before euthanizing a laboratory animal no longer
- 11 needed for laboratory research that the attending veterinarian, as
- 12 that term is defined in 9 CFR 1.1, determines is suitable for
- 13 adoption, a research facility shall offer the laboratory animal
- 14 directly to its employees or to an animal protection shelter
- 15 located in this state for adoption.
- 16 (2) A research facility that provides a former laboratory
- 17 animal to an animal protection shelter may enter into a written
- 18 agreement to carry out the purpose of subsection (1). A written
- 19 agreement under this subsection may include an acknowledgment that
- 20 the animal protection shelter accepts and takes responsibility for
- 21 any and all risks that may be associated with the former laboratory
- 22 animal and an agreement to waive the right to hold the research
- 23 facility liable for behavioral or health issues.
- 24 (3) An animal protection shelter that places a laboratory
- 25 animal received from a research facility under subsection (1) for
- 26 adoption shall enter into a written agreement with the individual
- 27 that adopts the former laboratory animal. A written agreement under
- 28 this subsection must include an acknowledgment that the adopting
- 29 individual understands that the animal was a former laboratory

- 1 animal. A written agreement under this subsection may also require
- 2 that the adopting individual accepts any and all risks that may be
- 3 associated with the former laboratory animal and an agreement to
- 4 waive the right to hold the animal protection shelter liable for
- 5 behavioral or health issues.
- 6 (4) This section may be known as "Teddy's law".
- 7 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act does not take effect
- 8 unless Senate Bill No. 148 of the 102nd Legislature is enacted into
- **9** law.
