A bill to amend 1969 PA 165, entitled

"An act to authorize the public service commission to establish and enforce gas safety standards; and to provide penalties for violations thereof,"

by amending section 11 (MCL 483.161), as amended by 1992 PA 11.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 11. (1) A person who that violates this act or a rule
- 2 promulgated under this act is subject to a an administrative fine
- 3 of not more than \$10,000.00 \$200,000.00 for each violation for each
- 4 day that the violation persists, except that the maximum civil
- 5 penalty administrative fine shall not exceed \$500,000.00

- 1 \$2,500,000.00 for any related series of violations.
- 2 (2) No sooner than September 1, 2024, and by October 1 of each
 3 year thereafter, the commission shall issue an order adjusting the
 4 administrative fines under subsection (1) for inflation using the

- 6 (3) (2)—In determining the amount of the administrative fine
 7 under subsection (1), the commission shall consider all of the
 8 following:
- 9 (a) The effect on the ability of the person charged to to continue in business.
 - (b) The nature, circumstances, and gravity of the violation.

 - (d) The degree of culpability of the person. charged.
- 15 (e) The history of prior violations of the person. charged.

- 18 (4) (3)—The amount of the penalty stipulated may be deducted
 19 from a sum the state owes the person charged—or may be recovered in
 20 a civil action in the Ingham county County circuit court.
 - (5) (4)—A person who willfully and knowingly defaces, damages, removes, or destroys a pipeline sign or right-of-way marker required by this act is guilty of a misdemeanor punishable by imprisonment for not more than 1 year —or by a fine of not more than \$5,000.00, or both, for each offense.
 - (6) An administrative fine issued under this section must be deposited in the general fund. For each calendar year, any amount of the administrative fines deposited in the general fund that exceeds \$200,000.00 must be credited to the commission to be used
