SUBSTITUTE FOR SENATE BILL NO. 148

A bill to amend 1969 PA 224, entitled

"An act to license and regulate dealers in and research facilities using dogs and cats for research purposes; and to repeal certain acts and parts of acts,"

by amending section 12 (MCL 287.392) and by adding sections 11a and 12a.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 11a. (1) By March 31 each year, a research facility that
- 2 uses dogs or cats shall submit a report to, and on a form provided
- 3 by, the department that includes all of the following information
- 4 regarding the preceding calendar year:
- 5 (a) The total number of dogs and cats owned by the research
- 6 facility.

- 1 (b) The total number of dogs and cats that are used for 2 laboratory research conducted at the research facility.
- 3 (c) The total number of dogs and cats released by the research 4 facility.
- 5 (2) The department shall use the information provided on a 6 report submitted under subsection (1) for purposes of determining 7 compliance under section 8a and shall not make any information 8 provided on the report available on the department's website.
- 9 Sec. 12. (1) Any Except as provided in subsection (2), a
 10 person who that violates any of the provisions of this act is
 11 quilty of a misdemeanor.
- 12 (2) If a research facility violates section 8a or 11a, the 13 department, after notice and opportunity for a hearing under the 14 administrative procedures act of 1969, 1969 PA 306, MCL 24.201 to 15 24.328, may impose an administrative fine as follows:
- 16 (a) If the violation involved 1 dog or cat, a fine of not more 17 than \$1,000.00.
- 18 (b) If the violation involved 2 or 3 dogs or cats, a fine of 19 not more than \$2,000.00.
- 20 (c) If the violation involved 4 or more dogs or cats but fewer 21 than 10 dogs or cats or the research facility has 1 prior violation 22 under section 8a or 11a, a fine of not more than \$3,000.00.
- 23 (d) If the violation involved 10 or more dogs or cats but 24 fewer than 25 dogs or cats or the research facility has 2 prior 25 violations under section 8a or 11a, a fine of not more than 26 \$5,000.00
- (e) If the violation involved 25 or more dogs or cats or the research facility has 3 or more prior violations under section 8a or 11a, a fine of not more than \$10,000.00.

- 1 (3) The department shall advise the attorney general of the
- 2 failure of a person to pay an administrative fine under subsection
- 3 (2). The attorney general shall bring an action to enforce
- 4 compliance with sections 8a and 11a and recover the administrative
- 5 fine, actual costs and fees, and attorney fees. The court shall
- 6 triple the administrative fine as part of any monetary judgment.
- 7 (4) An administrative fine collected under subsection (2) must
- 8 be deposited into the laboratory animal fund created under section
- 9 12a.
- 10 (5) One year after the effective date of the amendatory act
- 11 that amended this section, the department may issue a warning for a
- 12 violation of section 8a or 11a instead of imposing an
- 13 administrative fine under subsection (2).
- 14 Sec. 12a. (1) The laboratory animal fund is created within the
- 15 state treasury.
- 16 (2) The state treasurer may receive the administrative fines
- 17 collected under section 12(2) for deposit into the laboratory
- 18 animal fund. The state treasurer may also receive money or other
- 19 assets from any other source for deposit into the laboratory animal
- 20 fund. The state treasurer shall credit to the laboratory animal
- 21 fund interest and earnings from fund investments.
- 22 (3) Money in the laboratory animal fund at the close of the
- 23 fiscal year remains in the laboratory animal fund and does not
- 24 lapse to the general fund.
- 25 (4) The department is the administrator of the laboratory
- 26 animal fund for auditing purposes. The department shall expend
- 27 money from the laboratory animal fund to administer sections 8a,
- 28 11a, and 12.
- 29 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act does not take effect

- 1 unless Senate Bill No. 149 of the 102nd Legislature is enacted into
