A bill to amend 1939 PA 141, entitled "Grain dealers act,"

by amending section 6 (MCL 285.66), as amended by 2002 PA 80.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 6. (1) If a grain dealer has applied for a license but
- 2 needs additional time to comply with the requirements of this act
- ${f 3}$ for issuance of a license, the department may issue 1 temporary
- 4 permit to the applicant. A permit issued under this section expires
- ${f 5}$ on the expiration date set by the department, which may not be more
- 6 than 30-60 days after the permit is issued, when a license is

- issued, or when the application for license is denied, whichever
 ccurs first. The department may grant 1 extension 2 extensions of
 up to not more than 30 days of a permit issued under this section.
- 4 (2) A grain dealer who has been granted a permit under this
 5 section has the same rights and obligations of a licensee under
 6 this act.
