HOUSE SUBSTITUTE FOR SENATE BILL NO. 788

A bill to amend 1949 PA 300, entitled "Michigan vehicle code,"

(MCL 257.1 to 257.923) by adding section 803u.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 803u. (1) A woman who meets either of the following
- 2 requirements may apply to the secretary of state for a special
- 3 registration plate that displays an appropriate vignette preceding
- the registration numbers and has the words "woman veteran" 4
- inscribed beneath the registration numbers: 5
- (a) Was a member of the Michigan National Guard, the United 6
- 7 States Armed Forces Reserve, or any branch of the United States
- Armed Forces and was called to active duty during a declared war or 8
- 9 an armed conflict in which the United States was a participant.

- 1 (b) Was a member of any branch of the United States Armed
- 2 Forces, including reservists and National Guard, and has retired or
- 3 been granted an honorable discharge from that branch of the United
- 4 States Armed Forces.
- 5 (2) Application for a special registration plate must be on a
- 6 form prescribed by the secretary of state and must be accompanied
- 7 by any proof of the applicant meeting the requirements of
- 8 subsection (1) that the secretary of state may require. The
- 9 application for a special registration plate must not require a
- 10 service fee under section 804.
- 11 (3) On proper application, the secretary of state shall issue
- 12 1 or more special registration plates for each applicant for use on
- 13 a passenger vehicle. An individual who is disabled who applies for
- 14 a special registration plate under this section must be issued a
- 15 tab for persons with disabilities as provided in section 803f for
- 16 the special registration plate. The secretary of state shall
- 17 require the same proof that the applicant is a disabled person as
- 18 is required for issuing a permanent windshield placard under
- 19 section 675. A person issued 1 or more special registration plates
- 20 under subsection (1) must be assessed the applicable tax provided
- 21 in section 801.
- 22 (4) The use of a special registration plate on a vehicle other
- 23 than the vehicle for which the plate is issued, or by a person who
- 24 does not qualify under this section, is a misdemeanor.
- 25 (5) The special registration plate issued under this section
- 26 expires on the birthday of the vehicle owner. The applicant is not
- 27 required to furnish the proof provided in subsection (2) for an
- 28 application for renewal of the special registration plate.
- 29 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect November
