SUBSTITUTE FOR SENATE BILL NO. 858

A bill to amend 1931 PA 328, entitled "The Michigan penal code,"

by amending section 234d (MCL 750.234d), as amended by 1994 PA 158.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 234d. (1) Except as provided in subsection (2), a person
- 2 shall not possess a firearm on the premises of any of the
- 3 following:
- 4 (a) A depository financial institution or a subsidiary or
- 5 affiliate of a depository financial institution.
- 6 (b) A church or other house of religious worship.
- 7 (c) A court.
- 8 (d) A theatre.
- 9 (e) A sports arena.

- 1 (f) A day care center.
- 2 (g) A hospital.
- 3 (h) An establishment licensed under the Michigan liquor
- 4 control act, Act No. 8 of the Public Acts of the Extra Session of
- 5 1933, being sections 436.1 to 436.58 of the Michigan Compiled
- 6 Laws.code of 1998, 1998 PA 58, MCL 436.1101 to 436.2303.
- 7 (2) This section Subsection (1) does not apply to any of the following:
- 9 (a) A person who owns, or is employed by or contracted by, an
- 10 entity described in subsection (1) if the possession of that
- 11 firearm is to provide security services for that entity.
- 12 (b) A peace officer.
- (c) A person licensed by this state or another state to carry a concealed weapon.
- 15 (d) A person who possesses a firearm on the premises of an 16 entity described in subsection (1) if that possession is with the 17 permission of the owner or an agent of the owner of that entity.
- 18 (3) Except as provided in subsection (4), a person shall not 19 possess a firearm on the premises of any of the following:
- 20 (a) The Michigan State Capitol Building.
- 21 (b) The Anderson House Office Building.
- (c) The Binsfeld Senate Office Building.
- 23 (4) Subsection (3) does not apply to any of the following:
- 24 (a) A person who owns, or is employed by or contracted by, an
- 25 entity described in subsection (3) if the possession of that
- 26 firearm is to provide security services for that entity.
- 27 (b) A peace officer.
- 28 (c) A person carrying a concealed pistol if that person meets
- 29 both of the following conditions:

- 1 (i) Is licensed to carry a concealed pistol.
 - (ii) Is carrying the concealed pistol while that person is serving as a member of the Michigan house of representatives or the Michigan senate.
 - (5) As used in subsection (3), "premises" does not include parking areas of the places identified under subsection (3).
- 7 (6) (3) A person who violates this section is guilty of a
 8 misdemeanor punishable by imprisonment for not more than 90 days,
 9 or a fine of not more than \$100.00, or both.
