## SUBSTITUTE FOR SENATE BILL NO. 982

A bill to amend 1883 PA 129, entitled "An act for the organization of telephone and messenger service companies,"

(MCL 484.1 to 484.10) by adding section 7.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Sec. 7. (1) A telephone corporation formed under this act may convert into a domestic limited liability company if the telephone corporation satisfies the requirements applicable to the conversion of a business organization into a domestic limited liability company under section 709 of the Michigan limited liability company act, 1993 PA 23, MCL 450.4709. A telephone corporation that converts into a domestic limited liability company under this
- 8 subsection is treated as a corporation for state income tax filing

- 1 purposes as provided under section 339 of the income tax act of
- 2 1967, 1967 PA 281, MCL 206.339, unless that converted entity is a
- 3 disregarded entity for federal income tax filing purposes under the
- 4 internal revenue code and its regarded owner is treated as a
- 5 corporation for state and federal income tax purposes.
- 6 (2) As used in this section, "business organization" means
- 7 that term as defined in section 705a of the Michigan limited
- 8 liability company act, 1993 PA 23, MCL 450.4705a.
