THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Sec. 1. This act may be cited as the "athletic associations

- 5 Sec. 5. (1) A policy, bylaw, rule, or regulation of an
- 6 athletic association may not limit the distance that a high school
- 7 baseball or softball team may travel in this country for a game,
- 8 series, or tournament.
- 9 (2) A policy, bylaw, rule, or regulation that violates
- 10 subsection (1) is invalid and unenforceable.
