"An act to prohibit local units of government from imposing certain restrictions on the ownership, registration, purchase, sale, transfer, transportation, or possession of pistols, other firearms, or pneumatic guns, ammunition for pistols or other firearms, or components of pistols or other firearms,"

by amending section 3 (MCL 123.1103), as amended by 2015 PA 29.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 3. This act does not prohibit a local unit of government
- 2 from doing any of the following:
- 3 (a) Prohibiting or regulating conduct with a pistol, other

- 1 firearm, or pneumatic gun that is a criminal offense under state
- 2 law.
- 3 (b) Prohibiting or regulating the transportation, carrying, or
- 4 possession of pistols, other firearms, or pneumatic guns by
- 5 employees of that local unit of government in the course of their
- 6 employment with that local unit of government.
- 7 (c) Regulating the possession of pneumatic guns within the
- 8 local unit of government by requiring that an individual below the
- 9 age of 16 who is less than 16 years of age who is in possession of
- 10 a pneumatic gun be under the supervision of a parent, a guardian,
- 11 or an individual 18 years of age or older, except that an ordinance
- 12 shall not regulate possession of a pneumatic gun on or within
- 13 private property if the individual below the age of 16 who is less
- 14 than 16 years of age is authorized by a parent or guardian and the
- 15 property owner or legal possessor to possess the pneumatic gun.
- 16 (d) Prohibiting an individual from pointing, waving about, or
- 17 displaying a pneumatic gun in a threatening manner with the intent
- 18 to induce fear in another individual.
- 19 (e) Prohibiting the open carry of firearms within the local
- 20 unit of government.
