GENERAL SECTIONS

Sec. 201. Pursuant to section 30 of article IX of the state constitution of 1963, total state spending from state sources under part 1 for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2023 is \$0.00 and total state spending from state sources to be paid to local units of government is \$0.00.

- (b) Designating land owned by this state under the jurisdiction of the department in a county with a population of not less than 12,980 and not greater than 12,985 according to the most recent federal decennial census as a state veterans cemetery.
- 12 (c) Applying for and accepting all grants available under 38 13 USC 2408.
- (d) Cemetery design or engineering plans, or both, and anynecessary environmental impact studies prescribed by law.
- 16 (e) Necessary expenses to qualify for federal grants under 38
 17 USC 2408.
 - (f) Preparing the land that is acquired or purchased for a state veterans cemetery or designated as a state veterans cemetery for operational use.
 - (g) Ongoing expenses related to the operation of a state veterans cemetery.
- veterans cemetery are designated as a work project appropriation.
 Any unencumbered or unallotted funds shall not lapse at the end of the fiscal year and shall be available for expenditures for the project under this section until the project has been completed.
