

# HOUSE BILL NO. 4393

April 12, 2023, Introduced by Reps. O'Neal, Breen, Hood, Farhat, Brabec, Morse, Price, Weiss, Brenda Carter, Tsernoglou, Hope, Haadsma and Scott and referred to the Committee on Labor.

A bill to make, supplement, and adjust appropriations for various state departments and agencies for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2023; to provide for certain conditions on appropriations; and to provide for the expenditure of the appropriations.

PROVISIONS CONCERNING APPROPRIATIONS

GENERAL SECTIONS

14 Sec. 201. Pursuant to section 30 of article IX of the state  
 15 constitution of 1963, total state spending from state sources under  
 16 part 1 for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2023 is  
 17 \$5,000,000.00 and total state spending from state sources to be  
 18 paid to local units of government is \$0.00.

19 Sec. 202. The appropriations made and expenditures authorized  
 20 under this part and part 1 and the departments, commissions,  
 21 boards, offices, and programs for which appropriations are made  
 22 under this part and part 1 are subject to the management and budget  
 23 act, 1984 PA 431, MCL 18.1101 to 18.1594.

DEPARTMENT OF ATTORNEY GENERAL

26 Sec. 301. (1) Funds appropriated in part 1 for payroll fraud  
 27 enforcement unit must be used to hire approximately 25 FTEs to  
 28 investigate and prosecute cases, including payroll fraud cases.

29 (2) The unexpended funds appropriated in part 1 for payroll

1 fraud enforcement unit are designated as a work project  
2 appropriation. Any unencumbered or unallotted funds shall not lapse  
3 at the end of the fiscal year and shall be available for  
4 expenditures for the project under this section until the project  
5 has been completed. The following is in compliance with section  
6 451a of the management and budget act, 1984 PA 431, MCL 18.1451a:

7 (a) The purpose of the project is to hire approximately 25  
8 FTEs to investigate and prosecute cases, including payroll fraud  
9 cases.

10 (b) The project will be accomplished by utilizing state  
11 employees.

12 (c) The total estimated cost of the project is \$5,000,000.00.

13 (d) The tentative completion date is September 30, 2027.

14 (3) As used in this section, "FTEs" means full-time equated  
15 employees.
