HOUSE BILL NO. 4461

April 25, 2023, Introduced by Reps. DeSana, Outman and Rigas and referred to the Committee on Agriculture.

A bill to amend 2000 PA 92, entitled "Food law,"

by amending section 4102 (MCL 289.4102), as amended by 2012 PA 178.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 4102. (1) A cottage food operation is exempt from the
- 2 licensing and evaluation provisions of this act. This exemption
- 3 does not include an exemption from the adulteration and other
- 4 standards imposed in this section or under this act, or both, and
- 5 does not limit the ability of the department to take appropriate

- 2 operation to meet the standards contained in 21 CFR part 110 or the
- 3 food code.
- 4 (2) Cottage food products shall must be prepackaged and
- 5 properly labeled prior to before sale.
- 6 (3) At a minimum, a A cottage food operation shall place on
- 7 the label of any food it produces or packages the following
- 8 information:
- 9 (a) The name and address of the business of the cottage food
- 10 operation.
- 11 (b) The name of the cottage food product.
- 12 (c) The ingredients of the cottage food product, in descending
- 13 order of predominance by weight.
- 14 (d) The net weight or net volume of the cottage food product.
- 15 (e) Allergen labeling as specified by federal labeling
- 16 requirements.
- 17 (f) If any nutritional claim is made, appropriate labeling as
- 18 specified by federal labeling requirements.
- 19 (g) The following statement printed in at least the equivalent
- 20 of 11-point font size in a color that provides a clear contrast to
- 21 the background: "Made in a home kitchen that has not been inspected
- 22 by the Michigan department of agriculture and rural development.".
- 23 (4) Cottage food products may be sold directly from the
- 24 cottage food operation to the consumer only, and not by internet or
- 25 mail order. Sales by consignment or at wholesale are prohibited.

- 2 subsection, gross sales shall must be computed on the basis of the
- 3 amount of gross sales within or at a particular domestic residence
- 4 and shall must not be computed on a per-person basis within or at
- 5 that domestic residence. The department may request in writing
- 6 documentation to verify the annual gross sales figure.
- 7 (6) Cottage food products shall must be stored only in the
- 8 primary domestic residence.
- 9 (7) An exemption under this section does not affect the
- 10 application of any other state or federal laws or any applicable
- 11 ordinances enacted by any local unit of government.
