THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 18830. (1) A licensee shall not perform by any means an
- 2 onychectomy, a partial or complete phalangectomy, or tendonectomy
- 3 procedure, or any other surgical procedure that prevents normal
- 4 functioning of the claws, toes, or paws, on a cat, unless the
- 5 procedure is necessary to address a therapeutic purpose.

- 2 (a) "Cat" means a domestic cat of the species Felis catus or a
 3 hybrid of that species. Cat includes, but is not limited to, a
 4 savannah cat, Serengeti cat, Maine coon, Bengal cat, or chausie.
- (b) "Therapeutic purpose" means a physical medical condition of a cat, including, but not limited to, an existing or recurring illness, infection, disease, injury, or abnormal condition in the claw of a cat that compromises the cat's health. Therapeutic purpose does not include a cosmetic or aesthetic reason or a reason

of convenience in keeping or handling a cat.
