

# HOUSE BILL NO. 4683

May 25, 2023, Introduced by Reps. Friske, Rigas, DeSana, Fox, Carra, Alexander, Cavitt and Maddock and referred to the Committee on Government Operations.

A bill to amend 1931 PA 328, entitled  
"The Michigan penal code,"  
(MCL 750.1 to 750.568) by adding section 14a.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1           Sec. 14a. (1) A person who willfully administers to any  
2 pregnant individual any medicine, drug, substance, or thing  
3 whatsoever, or who employs any instrument or other means  
4 whatsoever, with the intent to perform an abortion, unless the  
5 abortion is necessary to preserve the life of the pregnant  
6 individual, is guilty of a felony.

7           (2) If the abortion results in the death of the pregnant

1 individual, the person is guilty of manslaughter.

2 (3) In a prosecution under this section, it is not necessary  
3 for the prosecution to prove that no such necessity for the  
4 abortion existed.

5 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days  
6 after the date it is enacted into law.

7 Enacting section 2. This amendatory act does not take effect  
8 unless Senate Joint Resolution \_\_\_\_ or House Joint Resolution C  
9 (request no. 03057'23) of the 102nd Legislature becomes a part of  
10 the state constitution of 1963 as provided in section 1 of article  
11 XII of the state constitution of 1963.
