## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Sec. 364. (1) No house of the legislature nor any committee or subcommittee shall pass an appropriations bill that includes a

(a) The legislatively directed spending item is sponsored by a

- 2 (b) The sponsoring legislator provides a written statement
- 3 that contains all of the following information to the chairs of the
- 4 senate and house of representatives appropriations committees, the
- 5 senate and house fiscal agencies, and the legislative council:
- 6 (i) The sponsoring legislator's name.
- 7 (ii) The name and location of the intended recipient or, if
- 8 there is not an intended recipient, the intended location of the
- 9 project or activity.
- 10 (iii) The purpose of the legislatively directed spending item
- 11 and an explanation of why the legislatively directed spending item
- 12 is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds.
- 13 (iv) A description of any community support.
- 14 (v) A certification that neither the sponsoring legislator nor
- 15 the sponsoring legislator's immediate family has a direct or
- 16 indirect pecuniary interest in the legislatively directed spending
- 17 item.
- 18 (c) The written statement has been available to the public on
- 19 the internet as described in subsection (2) for not less than 48
- 20 hours.
- 21 (2) The legislative council shall make each written statement
- 22 received under subsection (1) available to the public on the
- 23 internet as soon as practicable after the receipt of the
- 24 information.
- 25 (3) As used in this section:
- (a) "Community support" includes, but is not limited to, all
- 27 of the following:
- 28 (i) A letter of support from an elected community leader.
- 29 (ii) A press article highlighting the need for the funding.

- 1 (iii) Support from a newspaper editorial board.
- 2 (iv) A community development plan or other publicly available
- 3 planning document that includes the item for which funding is

- 5 (v) A resolution passed by the governing body of a community.
- 6 (b) "Immediate family" means an individual's parent, child,
- 7 sibling, and spouse and a relative of any degree residing in the
- 8 same household as that individual.
- 9 (c) "Legislative council" means the legislative council
- 10 created under the legislative council act, 1986 PA 268, MCL 4.1101
- 11 to 4.1901.
- (d) "Legislatively directed spending item" means an
- 13 appropriation that authorizes or obligates a specific amount of
- 14 money for a contract or other expenditure with or a grant, loan, or
- 15 other economic assistance or incentive to a person, unit of local
- 16 government, or project or activity in a unit of local government,
- 17 other than through a formula-driven or competitive award process.
- 18 An appropriation may be a legislatively directed spending item
- 19 regardless of whether the allocation of the appropriation is based
- 20 on population figures or whether the appropriation has a private or
- 21 local purpose. Legislatively directed spending item includes, but
- 22 is not limited to, Michigan enhancement grants and Michigan
- 23 infrastructure grants.
- 24 (e) "Legislator" means a person duly elected and serving in
- 25 the Michigan house of representatives or the Michigan senate.
- 26 (f) "Sponsoring legislator" means the legislator who sponsors
- 27 a legislatively directed spending item under subsection (1)(a).
