## **HOUSE BILL NO. 4913**

A bill to amend 1978 PA 368, entitled "Public health code,"

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by amending section 7214 (MCL 333.7214), as amended by 2018 PA 107.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

Sec. 7214. The following controlled substances are included in schedule 2:

(a) Any of the following substances, except those narcotic drugs listed in other schedules, whether produced directly or indirectly by extraction from substances of vegetable origin, or independently by means of chemical synthesis, or by combination of

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extraction and chemical synthesis:

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2 (i) Opium and opiate, and any salt, compound, derivative, or
3 preparation of opium or opiate excluding nalaxone and its salts,
4 and excluding naltrexone and its salts, but including the
5 following:

Etorphine hydrochloride 6 Raw opium 7 Opium extracts Hydrocodone Opium Fluid-extracts 8 Hydromorphone 9 Powdered opium Metopon 10 Granulated opium Morphine Tincture of opium 11 Oxycodone

- (ii) A salt, compound, derivative, or preparation thereof which is chemically equivalent to or identical with a substance referred to in this subdivision, except that these substances do not include the isoquinoline alkaloids of opium.
- (iii) Opium poppy, poppy straw, and concentrate of poppy straw,
  the crude extract of poppy straw in either liquid, solid, or powder
  form, which contains the phenanthrene alkaloids of the opium poppy.
  - (iv) Coca leaves and any salt, compound, derivative, or preparation thereof which is chemically equivalent to or identical with any of these substances, except that the substances do not include decocainized coca leaves or extraction of coca leaves which extractions do not contain cocaine or ecgonine. The substances include cocaine, its salts, stereoisomers, and salts of stereoisomers when the existence of the salts, stereoisomers, and salts of stereoisomers is possible within the specific chemical designation.

(c) Unless listed in another schedule, any material, compound, mixture, or preparation which contains any quantity of the following substances having potential for abuse associated with a stimulant effect on the nervous system:

- (i) Amphetamine, its salts, optical isomers, and salts of itsoptical isomers.
- (ii) Any substance which contains any quantity of
  methamphetamine, including its salts, stereoisomers, and salts of
  stereoisomers.

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- 1 (iii) Phenmetrazine and its salts.
- (iv) Methylphenidate and its salts.
- 3 (d) Any material, compound, mixture, or preparation, including 4 its salts, isomers, and salts of isomers when the existence of the 5 salts, isomers, and salts of isomers is possible within the 6 specific chemical designation as listed in schedule 2, which 7 contains any quantity of the following substances having a 8 potential for abuse associated with the depressant effect on the 9 central nervous system: methaqualone, amobarbital, pentobarbital, 10 or secobarbital; or, any compound, mixture, or preparation 11 containing amobarbital, secobarbital, pentobarbital, or any salt 12 thereof in combination with itself, with another, or with 1 or more
  - (e) Marihuana, but only for the purpose of treating a debilitating medical condition as that term is defined in section 3(b) of the Michigan medical marihuana act, 2008 IL 1, MCL 333.26423, and as authorized under this act.
  - (f) Tianeptine sodium.

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20 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days 21 after the date it is enacted into law.
