by amending section 3 (MCL 28.273), as amended by 2019 PA 78.

- 1 are requested for employment-related or licensing-related purposes.
- 2 A fee must not be collected under this subsection if a fee for
- 3 taking and processing fingerprints is collected under any other
- 4 law. The fee must not exceed the actual cost of taking and
- 5 processing the impression of the fingerprints and completing a
- 6 criminal record check on that person. The fee must be collected and
- 7 forwarded to the state police by the licensing body or the
- 8 employer.
- 9 (2) Until October 1, 2023, the The department of state police
- 10 may charge a fee of \$10.00 for processing and completing a name-
- 11 based criminal record check. However, a fee must not be charged
- 12 under this subsection if a fee for processing the name-based
