by amending sections 2 and 4 (MCL 390.972 and 390.974), section 4 as amended by 2021 PA 40.

- (a) For an applicant enrolled in an eligible postsecondary
 institution during the 2020 spring term and the 2020-2021 academic
 year, 11 years after his or her the applicant's eligibility is
