HOUSE BILL NO. 5218

October 24, 2023, Introduced by Reps. Hill and Scott and referred to the Committee on Energy, Communications, and Technology.

A bill to require certain reports be submitted to the Michigan public service commission; and to provide for the powers and duties of certain state and local governmental officers and entities.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 1. As used in this act:
- 2 (a) "Commission" means the Michigan public service commission.
- 3 (b) "Utility" means that term as defined in section 6g of 1939
- 4 PA 3, MCL 460.6q.
- 5 Sec. 3. (1) Except as otherwise provided in subsection (2),

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- 1 beginning May 1, 2024, and by the first day of each month
- 2 thereafter, a utility that submits any of the following report
- 3 forms to the United States Energy Information Administration shall
- 4 also submit a copy of each report form to the commission:
- 5 (a) EIA-782C: Monthly Report of Prime Supplier Sales of
- 6 Petroleum Products Sold for Local Consumption.
- 7 (b) EIA-810: Monthly Refinery Report.
- 8 (c) EIA-815: Monthly Bulk Terminal and Blender Report.
- 9 (d) EIA-816: Monthly Natural Gas Liquids Report.
- 10 (2) The commission may develop and make available on its
- 11 website report forms that are substantially similar to and include
- 12 all of the same informational sections as the report forms listed
- 13 under subsection (1). If the commission develops and makes
- 14 available report forms under this subsection, a utility that is
- 15 required to submit a report form under subsection (1) may submit
- 16 either a report form developed under this subsection or a report
- 17 form described under subsection (1).
- 18 (3) A report form submitted under this section is exempt from
- 19 disclosure under the freedom of information act, 1976 PA 442, MCL
