HOUSE BILL NO. 5359

November 14, 2023, Introduced by Reps. Morgan and Skaggs and referred to the Committee on Judiciary.

A bill to amend 2004 PA 452, entitled "Identity theft protection act,"

by amending section 3 (MCL 445.63), as amended by 2010 PA 318.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 3. As used in this act:
- 2 (a) "Agency" means a department, board, commission, office,
- 3 agency, authority, or other unit of state government of this state.
- 4 The term Agency includes an institution of higher education of this
- 5 state. The term Agency does not include a circuit, probate,
- 6 district, or municipal court.

- 1 (b) "Breach of the security of a database" or "security
- 2 breach" means the unauthorized access and acquisition of data that
- 3 compromises the security or confidentiality of personal information
- 4 maintained by a person or agency as part of a database of personal
- 5 information regarding multiple individuals. These terms do Breach
- 6 of the security of a database or security breach does not include
- 7 unauthorized access to data by an employee or other individual if
- 8 the access meets all of the following:

- 4 (f) "Depository institution" means a state or nationally5 chartered bank or a state or federally chartered savings and loan
- 6 association, savings bank, or credit union.
- 7 (g) "Encrypted" means transformation of data through the use
- 8 of an algorithmic process into a form in which there is a low
- 9 probability of assigning meaning without use of a confidential
- 10 process or key, or securing information by another method that
- 11 renders the data elements unreadable or unusable.
- 12 (h) "False pretenses" includes, but is not limited to, a
- 13 false, misleading, or fraudulent representation, writing,
- 14 communication, statement, or message, communicated by any means to
- 15 another person, that the maker of the representation, writing,
- 16 communication, statement, or message knows or should have known is
- 17 false or fraudulent. The false pretense may be a representation
- 18 regarding a past or existing fact or circumstance or a
- 19 representation regarding the intention to perform a future event or
- 20 to have a future event performed.

- 17 (k) "Identity theft" means engaging in an act or conduct
- 18 prohibited in section 5(1).
- 19 (l) "Interactive computer service" means an information service
- 20 or system that enables computer access by multiple users to a
- 21 computer server, including, but not limited to, a service or system
- 22 that provides access to the internet or to software services
- 23 available on a server.
- 24 (m) "Law enforcement agency" means that term as defined in
- 25 section 2804 of the public health code, 1978 PA 368, MCL 333.2804.
- 26 (n) "Local registrar" means that term as defined in section
- 27 2804 of the public health code, 1978 PA 368, MCL 333.2804.
- 28 (o) "Medical records or information" includes, but is not
- 29 limited to, medical and mental health histories, reports,

- 1 summaries, diagnoses and prognoses, treatment and medication
- 2 information, notes, entries, and x-rays X-rays and other imaging
- 3 records.
- 4 (p) "Person" means an individual, partnership, corporation,
- 5 limited liability company, association, or other legal entity.
- 6 (q) "Personal identifying information" means a name, number,
- 7 or other information that is used for the purpose of identifying a
- 8 specific person or providing access to a person's financial
- 9 accounts, including, but not limited to, a person's name, address,
- 10 telephone number, driver license or state personal identification
- 11 card number, social security Social Security number, place of
- 12 employment, employee identification number, employer or taxpayer
- 13 identification number, government passport number, health insurance
- 14 identification number, mother's maiden name, demand deposit account
- 15 number, savings account number, financial transaction device
- 16 account number or the person's account password, any other account
- 17 password in combination with sufficient information to identify and
- 18 access the account, automated or electronic signature, biometrics,
- 19 stock or other security certificate or account number, credit card
- 20 number, vital record, or medical records or information.
- 21 (r) "Personal information" means the first name or first
- 22 initial and last name linked to 1 or more of the following data
- 23 elements of a resident of this state:
- 24 (i) Social security Security number.
- (ii) Driver license number or state personal identification
- 26 card number.
- 27 (iii) Demand deposit or other financial account number, or
- 28 credit card or debit card number, in combination with any required
- 29 security code, access code, or password that would permit access to

- 1 any of the resident's financial accounts.
- 2 (s) "Public utility" means that term as defined in section 1 3 of 1972 PA 299, MCL 460.111.
- 4 (t) "Redact" means to alter or truncate data so that no more
- 5 than 4 sequential digits of a driver license number, state personal
- 6 identification card number, or account number, or no more than 5
- 7 sequential digits of a social security Social Security number, are
- 8 accessible as part of personal information.
- 9 (u) "State registrar" means that term as defined in section
- 10 2805 of the public health code, 1978 PA 368, MCL 333.2805.
- 11 (v) "Trade or commerce" means that term as defined in section
- 12 2 of the Michigan consumer protection act, 1971—1976 PA 331, MCL
- **13** 445.902.
- 14 (w) "Vital record" means that term as defined in section 2805
- 15 of the public health code, 1978 PA 368, MCL 333.2805.
- 16 (x) "Webpage" means a location that has a uniform resource
- 17 locator, or URL, with respect to the world wide web or another
- 18 location that can be accessed on the internet.
