## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 1313b. (1) Beginning October 1, 2025, and every October 1
- 2 thereafter, the board of a school district or intermediate school
- 3 district, the board of directors of a public school academy, or the
- 4 governing body of a nonpublic school, as applicable, shall
- 5 distribute the informational notice developed under section 1313a

- 1 to the parent or legal guardian of each student enrolled in the
- 2 school district, intermediate school district, public school
- 3 academy, or nonpublic school. The informational notice may be
- 4 distributed electronically or by mail.
- 5 (2) By not later than October 1, 2025, the department shall
- 6 post the informational notice developed under section 1313a on the
- 7 department's website in English, Spanish, and Arabic.
- 8 (3) By not later than October 1, 2025, the board of a school
- 9 district or intermediate school district, the board of directors of
- 10 a public school academy, and the governing body of a nonpublic
- 11 school, as applicable, shall post links to the department webpages
- 12 described in subsection (2) on the website of the school district,
- 13 public school academy, or nonpublic school, as applicable.

- 15 services, a school district or intermediate school district, a

- 17 members, or employees of those institutions are immune from civil
