THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Sec. 5p. The department of attorney general shall establish 1 2 and maintain a concealed pistol license reciprocity website that 3 does all of the following:
 - (a) Lists all states that grant reciprocity to an individual who has been issued a concealed pistol license under section 5b.
- (b) For each state listed under subdivision (a), list the rules and restrictions that the individual who has been issued a 7 concealed pistol license under section 5b must follow while carrying a concealed pistol in that state.
