THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 1. As used in this act, "nondisclosure agreement" means
- 2 an agreement or contract that includes a provision or clause that
- 3 provides that a party to the agreement or contract is prohibited
- 4 from disclosing, discussing, describing, or commenting upon the
- 5 agreement or contract or any of its terms.
- 6 Sec. 3. (1) Beginning on and after the effective date of this
- 7 act, a member of the legislature shall not enter into a

- 1 nondisclosure agreement regarding any work done in that member's

- 3 (2) A nondisclosure agreement entered into in violation of
- 4 this act is void.
- 5 Sec. 5. This act applies to any nondisclosure agreement that
- 6 is entered into, amended, extended, or renewed on or after the
- 7 effective date of this act.
