## **HOUSE BILL NO. 5529**

February 29, 2024, Introduced by Reps. Tyrone Carter, Scott, Byrnes, Young, McFall, Brenda Carter, Neeley, McKinney, Edwards, Wilson, Martus, Dievendorf, Rogers, Skaggs and Snyder and referred to the Committee on Regulatory Reform.

A bill to amend 2018 IL 1, entitled "Michigan Regulation and Taxation of Marihuana Act," by amending section 7 (MCL 333.27957), as amended by 2023 PA 166.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Sec. 7. (1) The cannabis regulatory agency is responsible for implementing this act and has the powers and duties necessary to control the commercial production and distribution of marihuana.

  The cannabis regulatory agency shall do all of the following:

- 2 (b) Grant or deny each application for licensure and
- 3 investigate each applicant to determine eligibility for licensure,
- 4 including conducting a background investigation on each person
- 5 holding an ownership interest in the applicant.
- 6 (c) Ensure that marihuana establishments comply with this act
- 7 and the rules promulgated under this act by doing all of the
- 8 following:
- $\mathbf{9}$  (i) Performing investigations of compliance and regular
- 10 inspections of marihuana establishments.
- 11 (ii) Taking appropriate disciplinary action against a licensee,
- 12 including prescribing civil fines for violations of this act or the
- 13 rules promulgated under this act and suspending, restricting, or
- 14 revoking a state license.
- 15 (d) Hold at least 4 public meetings each calendar year for the
- 16 purpose of hearing complaints and receiving the views of the public
- 17 with respect to administration of this act.
- 18 (e) Collect fees for licensure and fines for violations of
- 19 this act or the rules promulgated under this act.
- (f) Deposit all fees collected for licensure into the
- 21 marihuana regulation fund established under section 14 and remit
- 22 all fines collected for deposit into the general fund.
- 23 (q) Submit an annual report to the governor covering the
- 24 immediately preceding year that includes all of the following:
- (i) The number of state licenses of each class issued.
- 26 (ii) Demographic information of licensees.
- 27 (iii) A description of enforcement and disciplinary actions
- 28 taken against licensees.
- (iv) A statement of revenues and expenses of the cannabis

- 3 (h) Employ personnel as necessary to adequately perform its4 duties.
- 5 (2) The cannabis regulatory agency may do either any of the6 following:

- (a) Enter into an agreement with an advisor or consultant as necessary to adequately perform its duties under this act.
- 9 (b) Enter into an agreement with an Indian tribe regarding
  10 marihuana-related regulatory issues that involve the interests of
  11 this state and the Indian tribe, including, but not limited to,
  12 issues related to the commercial growing, processing, sale,
  13 testing, transportation, and possession of marihuana.
  - (c) Establish and operate a marihuana reference laboratory.
- 15 (d) Collect, transport, and possess marihuana for the purpose 16 of testing and conducting research in support of cannabis 17 regulatory agency investigations and the development and 18 optimization of testing methods performed through the cannabis 19 regulatory agency reference laboratory.
  - (3) A person who has a pecuniary interest, directly or indirectly, in a marihuana establishment or tribal marihuana business may not be an employee, advisor, or consultant involved in the implementation, administration, or enforcement of this act. An employee, advisor, or consultant of the cannabis regulatory agency is not personally liable for any action at law for damages sustained by a person because of an action performed or done in the performance of the employee's, advisor's, or consultant's duties in the implementation, administration, or enforcement of this act.
  - (4) The department of state police shall cooperate and assist
