Sec. 556. (1) Any An employer of labor in this state,

employing both males and females, who shall not discriminate in any
way in the payment of wages as between individuals of different
sexes, religions, races, colors, national origins, ages, heights,

weights, marital statuses, or other characteristics or attributes
