

HOUSE BILL NO. 5631

March 20, 2024, Introduced by Reps. Paiz, MacDonell, McKinney, Dievendorf, Wegela, Edwards, Farhat, Rheingans, Morgan, Hood, Wilson, Brabec, Byrnes, Brixie, Price, McFall, Hope, Young, Koleszar, Hill and Weiss and referred to the Committee on Economic Development and Small Business.

A bill to amend 1961 PA 236, entitled
"Revised judicature act of 1961,"
(MCL 600.101 to 600.9947) by adding sections 3103, 3203, 5709, and
5774.

- 1 Sec. 3103. (1) A person that is required to give a notice
2 under this chapter shall comply with section 506b of the persons
3 with disabilities civil rights act, 1976 PA 220, MCL 37.1506b.
